Many times they frame the quilt top very nicely, but a pieced border can add something special. Pieced borders do not have to difficult if you use Seminole piecing and there are many variations possible depending on...

Using the Golden Ration, my finished border should be: 9.25" [This actually put the quilt at 71"x71"] Using Rule of Thumb, my finished border should be 7.5" to 10" Using a different Rule of Thumb, my border should be 1/3 of the finished block or 5" Scratch #3 – even with the 2" sashed inner border, it's still too small.

my suggestion relates to borders such as tipped bricks or braids, where you have to cut off the points 1/4" from the seam line -- a teacher showed me a couple years ago that it is better to draw a pencil line where the cutting line should be, and then sew the next border on (or sew this border to the quilt) BEFORE you cut off all the points.

Oh that's a great idea. So one example would be a feather, a feather is a really traditional design that a lot of machine quilters like to use, it looks gorgeous, but instead of quilting a feather one long line down the border, we can actually quilt it in chunks, which is actually what I've done on this quilt.

The key to adding borders that help keep your quilt square is measuring correctly. I've seen many quilters just measure the side of the quilt the border will be sewn to and cut the border to that length. Please, DO NOT do that! Also, please don't sew on a border strip and then cut it to length.

{Tip} The Importance of Correctly Adding Borders to a Quilt

The larger the border, the larger the print can be.-Decide how many borders you want: A skinny, solid-colored or simple border is a good way to break up busy prints.-Audition fabrics: If you're able, lay a corner of your quilt over the top of the border fabric, so the border fabric frames the quilt as if it were sewn on. Squint to blur (or as ...
